STANISLAUS COUNTY LAW LIBRARY INTERNET ACCESS POLICY

PURPOSE:

The Internet is available at the Stanislaus County Law Library for performing legal research

ACCESS:

- All users requesting use of the Internet must sign in at reference desk
- Use is restricted to one-half hour per day. Time blocks may be extended if not busy.
- Users must be at least 18 years of age or accompanied by an adult. Identification may be required. The adult is responsible for all material accessed by the minor.
- Written instructions are provided for the use of the Internet. The staff does not provide: individual instruction, research assistance, the staff also does not verify or interpret database information

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

The World Wide Web is made available through the Explorer browser.

PRINTING:

A printer is currently available for use at 10¢ per page. Please pay at the Reference Desk. Information may also be downloaded to a preformatted library diskette only (*no exceptions*) and is available for purchase (\$1.00). Once the diskette leaves the library it can not be reused in library workstations.

UNACCEPTABLE USES OF THE INTERNET:

Unacceptable use includes but is not limited to:

- Intentionally damaging or destroying equipment, software or data belonging to the Law Library or adding, altering, or deleting files on library workstations
- Eating or drinking while using library workstations
- Use of the Internet for any illegal activity
- Use of the Internet to harass others including but not limited to sexual harassment
- Use of the Internet to violate software or database license agreements
- Use of the equipment and /or software for commercial purposes
- Use of library workstations to access e-mail, chat rooms, or games

Penalties for unacceptable use of the Stanislaus County Law Library 's public workstations may include prohibiting future access to library facilities by the patron
